Course Summary

Course Description	<p>The course is divided into two parts. In the first part of the course, we begin by asking the basic questions of "what is international relations (IR)?" and "what is international political economy (IPE)?", and examining the major perspectives for understanding IR/IPE. We also examine international trade, finance, and environmental cooperation. Whereas in the first part of the course we look at political and economic relations between nations, in the second part of the course we look within nations to get a better understanding of how politics and economics are interrelated. Our perspective will be international in the sense that we will be examining the experiences of many countries. However, our ultimate goal in the second half of the course is to understand how political and economic forces interact within nations.</p>
