Course Description	The purpose of this course is to provide an overview of nature and contents of international trade law and practice. The main focus of this course will be placed on proper understanding of normative nature and function of the WTO.
Description Related Courses	This course should be understood as part of public international law. In this regard, it should be noted that this course shall pay also attention to the conflicting relationship between the idea of free trade and the problem of international environmental protection.
