It targets learners who have achieved TOPIK Level 4 or an equivalent level of Korean proficiency, and it comprehensively covers five areas: vocabulary/grammar, speaking, reading, listening, and writing.</p> <p>The course aims to help students achieve advanced Korean language skills essential for university life and academic pursuits. Through a combination of instructor-led lectures and student-driven activities—including advanced vocabulary/grammar exercises, presentations, discussions, and writing tasks—it enhances understanding of academic and specialized discourse and improves practical application skills. By the end of the course, learners will have a deep understanding of Korean society and culture and the ability to use the language freely in various formal and informal contexts.</p>
